

## 1. Before the Test

Below is a list of all the things you'll need to bring to our appointment. Please make sure you have them all or I won't be able to test you.

- **Photo ID** - You need to bring your state-issued ID so we know you're legal to drive. This can include your permit, license, student ID, or passport.

*Note - please bring your Skills Test Receipt if provided by the DMV after taking the written test.*

- **Your vehicle** - We will test in your personal vehicle. If the vehicle is not yours, we need verbal or written permission from the owner that you're OK to use the vehicle.
- **Vehicle readiness** - We need to make sure your car is legal to drive. Please make sure your vehicle's insurance and registration are current.
- **Tester Fee** - \$28.50 in cash.
- **Medical skills evaluation form** - Only required for a Medical Caution or reoccurring skills test requirement.

## 2. Test Day

Wondering what happens on the day of your test? Here's how it works:

- **Meet at the scheduled time** - Meet me at Lowell Scott Middle School at the scheduled time. I'll meet you at the flagpole in the front of the school.
- **Settle up with the examiner** - I will verify you have all the necessary documents and take your payment. Then we'll hop in your vehicle and begin the test.

## 3. Final Steps

So you've taken your test. What do I do now?

- **Get your results** - I will give you a sealed envelope with your test results.
- **Deliver results to the DMV** - Head to the DMV where they will open your envelope. If you passed, congratulations! Now you just pay the DMV fees and you get your license. If you did not pass, you have to wait 3 days to schedule a new test.
